Text Mark-Up Conventions for Ancient Languages through 204 level

1. Write **S** above all Subjects
2. Write **V** above Verbs
*connect complementary infinitives to governing verb with a line underneath
3. Write **O** above Objects of verbs.
*do not include Indirect Objects in this category
4. Write **C** above Subject Complements and Objective Complements.
5. Put square brackets around subordinate clauses [when you encounter them].
*include all clauses with infinitive or finite verbs, but not participles.
6. Put parentheses (around prepositional phrases).
7. Draw arrows from adjectival modifiers to their nounheads.
* adjectival modifiers include adjectives, participles and genitive nouns & pronouns
8. Draw a box around all coordinating conjunctions such as *et* and *sed*.
